We will be going on July 9th to Emerald Point in Greensboro. We will meet at the church at 9am. We will have lunch there. Please contact Patty for more info to follow!

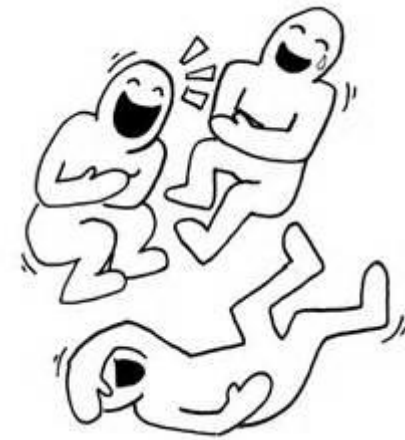
KIDS COOK OFF
