FRANK SUNDAY

"Why have you brought us up out of Egypt, to bring us to this wretched place? It is no place for grain, or figs, or vines, or pomegranates; and there is no water to drink." (Numbers 20:5)

In the Old Testament, *Numbers* 20, Israelites complain about the lack of water to drink. In the wilderness, water is like their life. Without water, the Israelites easily forget their miserable slavery life in Egypt and confront their leaders, Moses and Aaron, with anger, complaint, and doubt. When Moses and Aaron fall down before God in prayer, God speaks to Moses to command the rock to yield water so that the people and their livestock can drink!

In this story, we learn that God always prepares water for Israelites in the wilderness. In fact, the Scripture describes that not only water but also God was there with them in the wilderness!


