BREAKING CHRISTIAN MYTHS

O Lord, you have searched me and known me... Where can I go from your spirit?... For it was you who formed my inward parts; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. (Psalm 139:1-14a)

Psalm 139 is one of my favorite psalms because it depicts our intimate relationship with God. While many Christians believe in the love of God who is Creator, Redeemer, and Sustainer, they also may keep false myths.

Myth 1: It is us who seek God's presence. I know that many Christians endeavor to seek God in their daily lives by praying, reading Bible, and doing good works. "I search for God but often fail to find God in my life." Have you desperately searched for God? However, Psalm 139 tells us that it is God who has searched us and known us. God knows our thoughts and ways. While we may seek God only when we need God's help, God seeks us always and knows us completely!

Myth 2: We are too small, and God is too big. When we do not immediately hear God's answer for our prayers, we tend to think that God is too big and far from us. When we get disappointed with ourselves, we feel that we are too small. It seems that God is too big and righteous to be close to us. "God does not care for me!" We may even feel lost and astray. However, the psalm speaks to us that we cannot flee from God. God *hems* us *in*, *behind* and before. The truth is that **God cares for us whatever small we are!**

Myth 3: We are nobody! Life's stormy waves often attack us, and we may become losers in life. We even sense that we are nothing and nobody. However, the psalm gives us truth that we are *fearfully and wonderfully made* by God! We are not nobody, but God's precious masterpiece!

By breaking Christian myths, let us rebuild our relationship with God. Our God seeks us always and knows us completely. Our God meets us and cares for us. Our God welcomes and embraces us as who we are!

ANNUAL CONFERENCE




